All students must:

- Complete the **YELLOW VERIFICATION FORM**. Choose at least 5 electives and mark each with your order of preference.
- Turn in your **YELLOW VERIFICATION FORM**. **Please do not take this form home!** This is the only record we will have of the electives your student wishes to take.
- Please note: As you and your student consider which courses he/she should take, keep in mind that North Gwinnett High School does yearlong registration. **This means that whatever classes your student elects to take during registration will be his/her classes for the entire next school year.** Therefore, make sure you and your student carefully consider all choices available. North Gwinnett hires teachers in the spring for the next school year based upon your student's decision in all areas and schedule changes will not be honored after registration closes on June 1st.

A final course verification will be mailed home in May and requests can be made until June 1st.
